As a recently retired Pastor of 42 years, I often look back over the years of joy and promise from having served in 5 congregations. There were challenges, to be sure. However, they served to undergird my faith and to bring me closer to God and to the People of God. One of those enriching and fulfilling times was when one of my parishes intentionally yoked in a partnership with *Connections Stewardship Group.*

The sharing of the information that John gathered was an eye opener for all members and boosted the people by calling them to task in areas that needed improvement. This thorough and hands-on process pointed out exciting ways that new ministries would enhance the total outreach of our church to the neighboring community.
